The Rosary

The Mysteries of Light (Pr 7)
reflect on the life of Jesus through
the eyes of Mary his Mother. They
are prayed in a decade, a block of
prayer comprising of an Our Father,
10 Hail Marys, a Glory be.

I believe in one God, the Father
almighty, maker of heaven and earth,
of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,
the Only Begotten Son of God, born
of the Father before all ages.

God from God, Light from Light,
true God from true God, begotten,
not made, **consubstantial** with the
Father; through him all things were
made. For us men and for our
salvation he came down from heaven,
and by the Holy Spirit was **incarnate**
of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under
Pontius Pilate, he suffered death
and was buried, and rose again on
the third day in accordance with the
Scriptures. He ascended into heaven
and is seated at the right hand of
the Father.

He will come again in glory to
judge the living and the dead and his
kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the
Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds
from the Father and the Son, who
with the Father and the Son is
adored and glorified, who has spoken
through the prophets. I believe in
one, holy, catholic, and apostolic
Church. I confess one baptism for
the forgiveness of sins and I look
forward to the resurrection of the
dead and the life of the world to
come. Amen.

The Angelus

V. The angel of the Lord declared
unto Mary.

R. And she conceived by the Holy

R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary...

Stations of the Cross

Stations are places where people wait while they are going from one place to another. A school-bus stop is like a station. People wait at train stations or bus stations or airports. Think of some stations where you have been.

Stations are also places where people take time to think about Jesus as he went to die on a cross. They are "Stations of the Cross." They show us how much Jesus loved us.

You do not have to think of all of the Stations of the Cross on one day. You may want to stay at one Station with Jesus for a few days before you move to another Station. Whatever you decide, Jesus is with you and he loves you.

Inspired with this confidence, I fly to thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother; to thee do I come; before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

Hail, Holy Queen

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy, hail, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve: to you do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears.
